

1. There will be two winners of this contest, as follows:
 - A. First Winner: The individual who raises the most money overall, (to include corporate sponsorships and individual fundraising), for The Ireland Funds Young Leaders Global 5K. The First Winner must be a paid up member of The Ireland Funds Young Leaders Society. The First Winner can be from any of the 17 cities hosting The Ireland Funds Young Leaders Global 5K.
 - B. Second Winner: The individual will be chosen in a draw. To be eligible to enter the draw the individual must raise the equivalent of US\$500.00 for The Ireland Funds Young Leader Global 5K in their jurisdiction. The draw will take place in The Ireland Funds' New York office on Wednesday 27 September 2017, and will be performed by an independent auditor from KPMG, our presenting sponsors.
2. The prize for the first winner and the second winner is a certificate for two (2) adult round trip coach tickets to any Delta Air Lines destination. The Delta Airlines certificate is non-transferable and must be used within 12 months of receipt of the Delta certificate.
3. For the purpose of calculating the qualifying amounts above, the local amounts raised will be converted into US Dollars based on the currency conversion rates in effect on Wednesday, 27 September, 2017.
4. The Delta Certificate will issue to the first winner and the second winner once the qualifying amounts have been received.
5. The contest is open to those over 21 years of age only.
6. Employees of The Ireland Funds are not eligible to win this prize.
7. In the case of any disputes as to the implementation of the above rules, the decision of Patrick Tully, National Director of the Young Leaders/New York Regional Director and Siobhán Gallagher, Director of The Ireland Funds Young Leaders shall be final.
