An especially warm welcome to new friends of the Fund joining us for the first time. 2018 was an incredible year which saw us have a record-breaking grant round of over \$1.8 million to projects in Ireland and in Australia, details of which can be found on the following pages. We partnered for the second year with Science Gallery Melbourne, an award-winning international initiative pioneered by Trinity College Dublin. Our support provided an opportunity for an indigenous student to work part time in Melbourne for this year's exhibition and to travel to Ireland's Science Gallery. It also assisted bringing a classroom of students from disadvantaged areas in Melbourne and Dublin to visit the Exhibition in those cities.

We continued to support Integrated Education in Northern Ireland through the Integrate My School initiative creating awareness about how schools can transform to integrated status, and via direct support to Drumragh Integrated College. We have seen tragic violence in Derry recently which reminds us that Peace is a Process, we cannot take it for granted and it needs to be nurtured. Our continued support of Integrated Education is vital.

I am extremely proud of the work that the Young Leaders have done in Sydney, Melbourne and Brisbane. Last year saw them hold their most successful Global 5K, a corporate breakfast at LinkedIn and a health & wellbeing event, raising more than \$37,000 for worthwhile charities in Ireland and in Australia. In February they held a strategy session at the Irish Embassy in Canberra to plan for the future of the Fund. They are the new generation of the Ireland Funds and are working hard to continue to build our philanthropic community here in Australia.

I would like to finish with my heartfelt thanks to you all for joining us here tonight and for your support and donations throughout the year. Having personally seen several of the projects we support in action, and their impacts, I can assure you that with your help the

support we provide changes lives, many of them young lives. To provide opportunity where previously there was only hopelessness is a powerful gift to be able to give and I thank you for enabling us to give it on your behalf.
