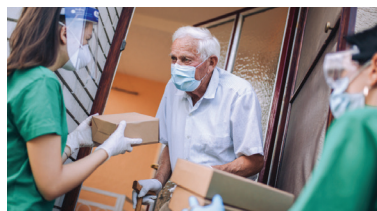
OUR GIVING PROGRAMMES
