### THE IRELAND FUNDS COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP AWARD RECIPIENTS

JAMES R. BORYNACK is Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Wally Findlay Galleries International, Inc. Together with his partner, Adolfo Zaralegui, they uphold a 50-year philanthropic legacy, hosting and underwriting premier exhibitions and galas for a wide range of charitable organizations across its gallery network.

Mr. Borynack, who chaired the National Hospice Foundation and its Board of Governors,

was a Board Member of the Trustbridge Hospice Foundation of Palm Beach and Broward Counties. He is a member of the United Way's Tocqueville Society, serves on the United Way of Palm Beach Board of Directors, and was the recipient of the Town of Palm Beach United Way's Distinguished Citizen Award, its highest accolade. He is also Chairman of the Palm Beach Symphony and Director of the Palm Beach Civic Association.

The Hope for Depression Research Foundation jointly honored Mr. Borynack and his partner, Adolfo Zaralegui, with its HOPE Corporate Visionary Award. In 2023, he received the Lighthouse Guild Visionary Award and the 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Alexis de Tocqueville Society Award. Mr. Borynack is an Ambassador's Circle member of the World Jewish Congress and serves as president of the US Committee for UNESCO. He also served on the Board of Directors for the David S. Wyman Institute for Holocaust Studies and The Manhattan Jewish Health Services for Hospice.

He is a founding Trustee of the American Foundation for the Pontifical Institute of Theology at Posillipo (Naples, Italy) and a sustaining member of the Patrons of The Vatican Museums. In 2023, he received the Distinctive

He was Board Development Chair of the American Ballet Theatre, an advisor to the NY State Prison in Art Programs, a member of the President's Council of the New School, and is currently a member of the Order of St. John and the Social Register Foundation Advisory Committee.

Beyond the artworld, Mr. Zaralegui serves on the Board of Directors of Hospice of Palm Beach County Trustbridge Foundation and The Impresario Society of the Palm Beach Symphony. He served on the Children of Bellevue Advisory Board in New York City, and currently serves on The Chairman's Council of Hope for Depression Research Foundation.

Within the realm of medical philanthropy, Mr. Zaralegui supports the University of Miami Health System, Bascom Palmer Eye Institute, Sylvester Comprehensive Cancer Center, and UHealth Ear Institute.
