1. How to access the grant application portal

The Grants page on The Ireland Funds website <u>https://irelandfunds.org/grants</u> is where you will find all information, guidelines and additional materials relating to the Heart of the Community Fund, along with a link to the online grants portal.

When you have read the <u>application guidelines</u> and have confirmed that your organisation is eligible to apply to the Heart of the Community grant round, the first step is to access the grant application.

The Ireland Funds uses Titan Forms to facilitate applications to the Heart of the Community Fund. Please review our <u>privacy policy</u> for information about how we manage and store your data.

Scroll to the section 'How to Apply' and click 'Apply Now' to visit our grant application portal.



1.1. How to create an account on the portal

The Ireland Funds online portal was started in late 2022, so any organisation that did not apply for Heart of the Community Fund 2022 and/or 2023 will need to create an account.

If you created an account for Heart of the Community Fund 2022 or 2023, please skip to step 13, 'Log into the Grants Portal'.

Guidance for New Applicant Organisation i.e. did not apply to 2022 or 2023 grant round

- 1. You will be directed to the below webpage, which is the homepage of The Ireland Funds grants portal.
- 2. Select the 'Create Your Account' button in the top right hand corner.

3. The below page will appear requesting you to confirm your eligibility. Select your answers and click 'Continue'.



4. The below page will appear if you pass the initial account eligibility requirements. Click 'Register' to continue.

- 11. Once you submit, you will be directed to a confirmation page.
- 12. Form Titan will automatically generate an email with a link for you to verify your email address and finalise the account set-up. This email will be sent from the following address: <u>noreply@formtitan.com</u>. Click the link in the email to verify and return to the log-in page.
 *Please note that depending on your email server, this email may be flagged as 'Spam'/'Junk' so if you have not received the email 5-10

minutes after registering, please check these folders.

You should now be able to log into the grants portal. Proceed to step 13.

2. Start Your Application to Heart of the Community Fund

- 1. Once you have entered the verification code and clicked 'Log In', you will be directed to the home page of The Ireland Funds grantee portal.
- 2. Click 'Apply here for Heart of the Community Fund 2024' to view the grant round that is currently open.



3. Click the magnifying glass next to 'Heart of the Community Fund 2024' to view the grant opportunity.



4. The next page will display information about the grant round. You can commence your application by clicking 'Verify Eligibility'. Please note: each organisation can only have one active grant application in progress for a given grant round. Once you click this button, you will be starting the grant application for your organisation.

3. Frequently Asked Questions

i. Can I save and return to an application?

Yes, applications can be completed in stages and progress can be saved. We would encourage all applicants to save their applications frequently to ensure that no information is lost.

This can be done by scrolling to the bottom of the page and locating the 'Save and Next'. Selecting this will save all progress made on that section of the application form. Please note that in order to be able to save, all fields on that page must be inputted and fully complete - you cannot save a page if any fields are blank
