We are part of the worldwide Ireland Funds active in 12 countries around the world. We are the largest private donor to Irish causes.

Locally here in Australia we have assisted the three Irish Support Agencies in NSW, QLD and VIC to name a few.

This year we continued our Women in Leadership and Philanthropy series bringing powerful women together to share their knowledge with women of all ages to genuinely help each other as we empower, inspire and give. We are looking forward to providing details of further events that are under planning.

I am extremely proud of the unity, resilience and intelligence displayed by our staff, our voluntary Board and Young Leaders who have all helped to continue supporting those who rely on us over these last few very challenging years. World events and local events remind us that caring for each other, investing in and continually nurturing the work we do around peace, reconciliation and community development is vital.




