Heart of the Community Fund 2025

This year, The Ireland Funds will deliver the Heart of the Community Fund **through two separate grant rounds**. The **first round** will launch on **29 May** and support organisations in **Northern Ireland**. The **second round** will support organisations in the **Republic of Ireland** (dates TBC). This approach allows us to better address the needs of each region and maximise the positive outcomes of our funding.

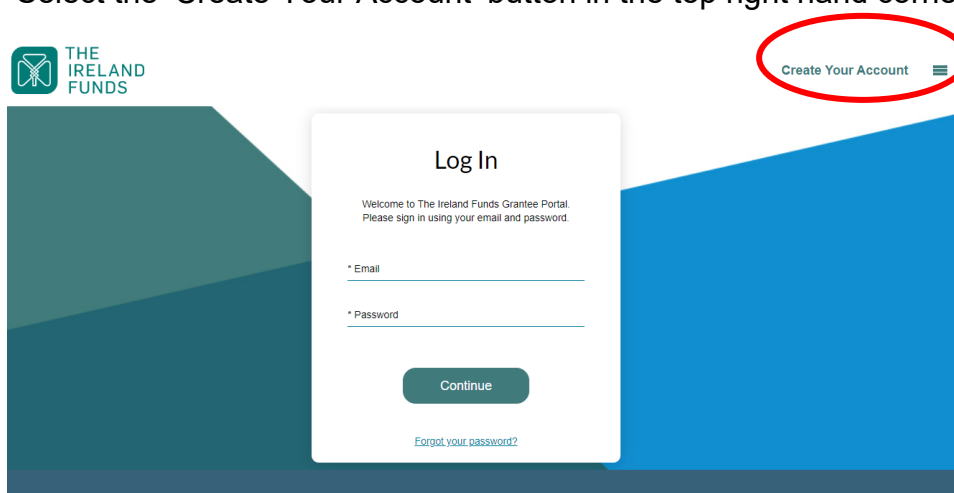
1.1. How to create an account on the portal

The Ireland Funds online portal was started in late 2022, so any organisation that did not apply for Heart of the Community Fund in 2022-2024 will need to create an account.


If you created an account for Heart of the Community Fund in a previous year, please skip to step 13, 'Log into the Grants Portal'.

1. You will be directed to the below webpage, which is the homepage of The Ireland Funds grants portal.
2. Select the 'Create Your Account' button in the top right hand corner.



3. The below page will appear requesting you to confirm your eligibility. Select your answers and click 'Continue'.

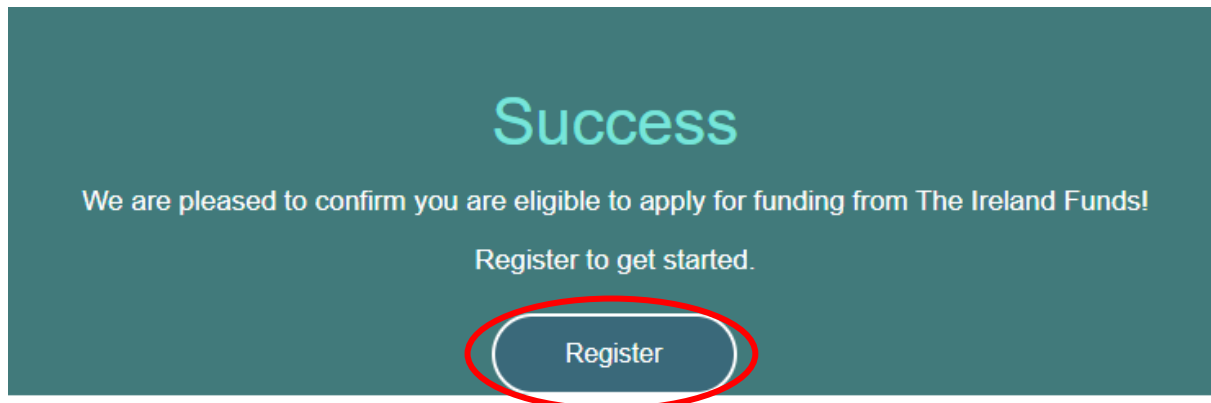

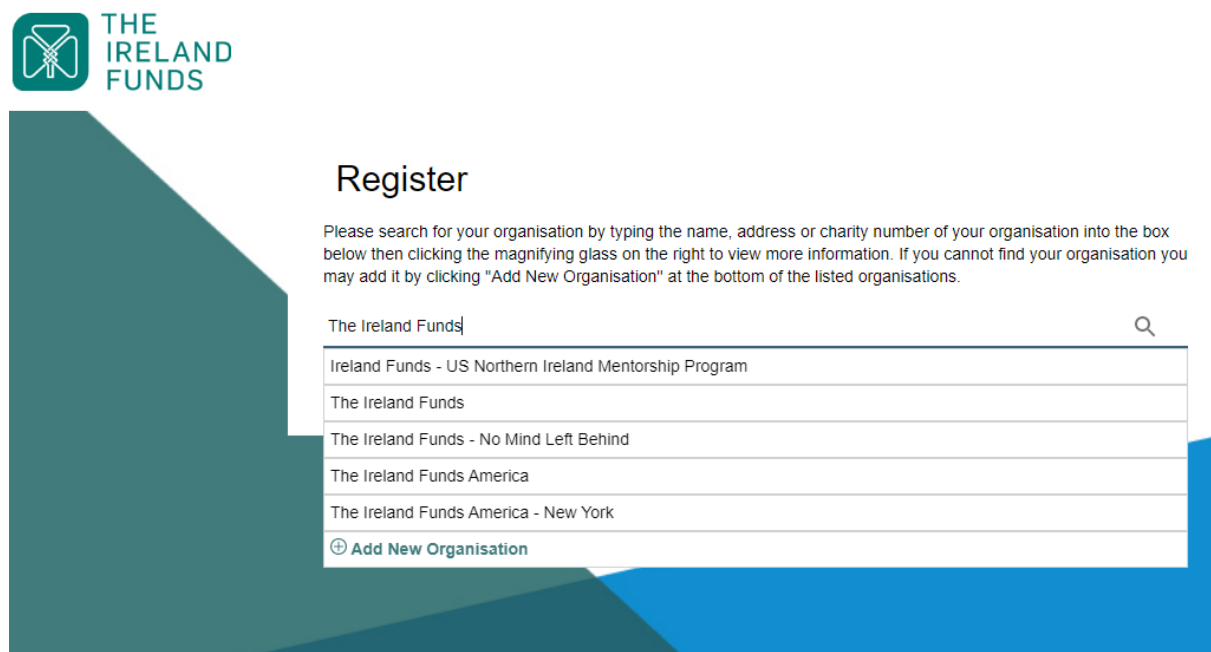



12. Form Titan will automatically generate an email with a link for you to verify your email address and finalise the account set-up. This email will be sent from the following address: noreply@formtitan.com. Click the link in the email to verify and return to the log-in page.
***Please note that depending on your email server, this email may be flagged as 'Spam'/'Junk' so if you have not received the email 5-10 minutes after registering, please check these folders.**

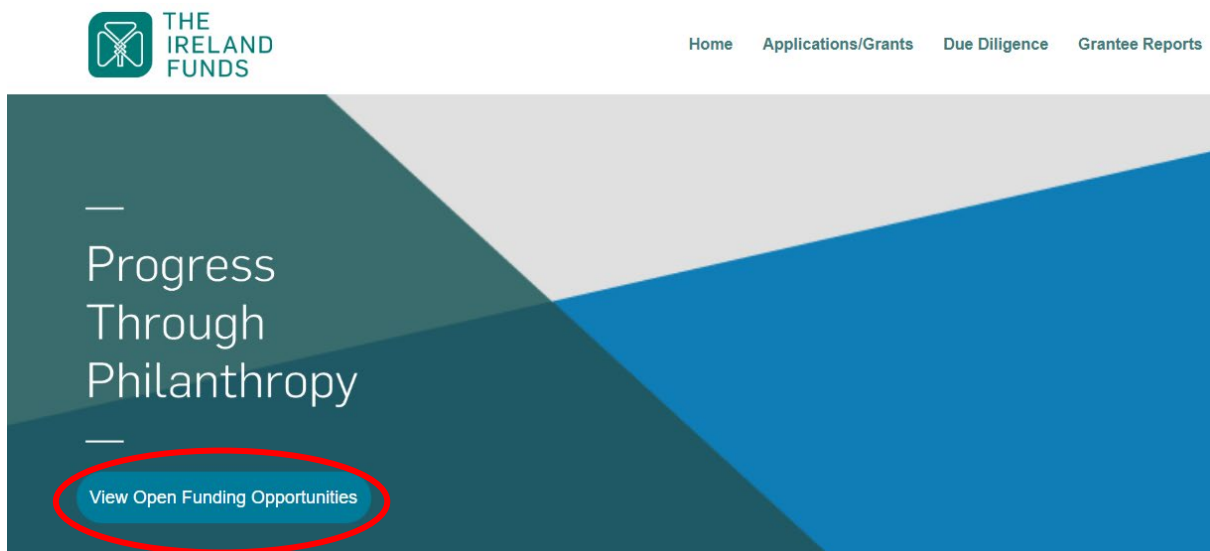

Description

The Heart of the Community Fund Round 1 is an open grant round designed to meet the needs of not-for-profit organisations delivering vital services and supports to people in Northern Ireland.

The Ireland Funds recognises the challenges organisations face in securing funding to build their capacity or meet their core costs, so the Heart of the Community Fund 2025 will provide Organisational Investment Grants. The application form will enable you to share what you're working towards and how you deliver on your mission, so we can get a picture of your organisation as a whole. If your application is successful, you can then allocate the funding to meet your most pressing needs.

Priorities of the Heart of the Community Fund 2025

For the first round of the Heart of the Community Fund for 2025, within our four pillars, we will prioritise applications from organisations working in Northern Ireland in the following areas:

- Organisations across Northern Ireland working with youth (0-23 years) to encourage civic leadership, providing opportunities for upskilling and employment, and investing in youth talent and ambition; and
- Organisations across Northern Ireland tackling and providing mental health supports.

Priority:

Within these focus areas, organisations working in hard to reach rural communities.

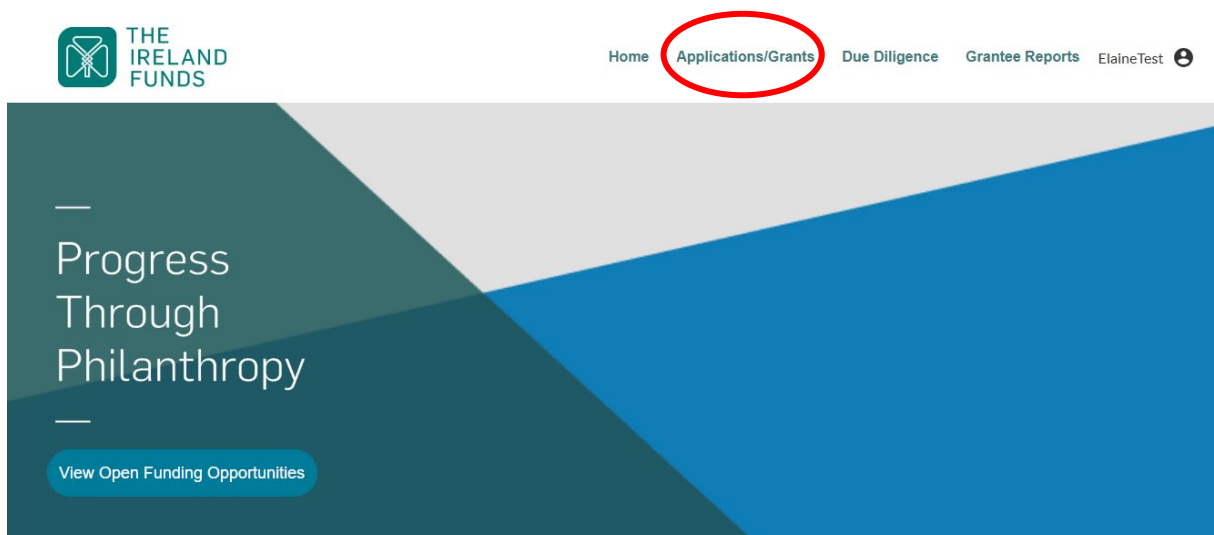
