In 2026, The Ireland Funds Singapore is supporting **Young Persons with Special Needs & Youth at Risk, Palliative Care, and Education & the Arts** with major and small grant awards totaling **\$600,000**. Major grant awards include:

- **Extra.Ordinary People** – Inclusive Performing Arts programme for youth with special needs
- **Autism Resource Centre** – Classroom for vocational training youth with autism and The Art Faculty for artists with autism
- **Down Syndrome Association** – Bridging Programme supporting youth with Down Syndrome transition from school to employment
- **Dover Park Hospice** – Refurbishment for Day Care Centre supporting palliative patients at Dover Park Hospice
- **LASALLE College of the Arts** – The McNally Legacy at LASALLE with bursaries for disadvantaged students and the Creative Brain Week initiative

Small grant awards to our beneficiaries under our four pillars in 2026 include **Boys' Town, Tasek Academy, iC2 Prehouse, BeKind SG, Atlas Foundation, Irish Inspirational Dance, and New Opera Singapore.**

As an Institution of Public Character, donations to The Ireland Funds Singapore are eligible for **250% Tax-deductible Receipt.**
